Saddleback will provide standard telephone service and any of the typical high-speed digital services of a modern communications company. Our Central Office is equipped with a DMS 500 Nortel Switch connected to two Qwest Central Offices by a diversified fiber network. During the construction process we can provide service to construction trailers as long as they have AC power. This is accomplished with our fixed wireless service that provides two 64 kb channels for local phone service.

Typically the site developer is required to furnish a conduit structure throughout their development and Saddleback Communications will provide all other facilities required to provide service to the MPOP. The conduit structure provided must meet Saddleback specifications. Please have your architects contact us during the design stage to insure the communications infrastructure is adequate for your project.
